Research Objectives

Proposals that focus on defining the natural history, early detection and diagnosis, or novel treatment strategies will be given priority.

- Clinical drug trials must meet requirements established by the U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA).
- No funds may be used for indirect costs.
